LOOP LOVE looks like this!
You make voice sounds into it and then it plays them back!



Using Loop Love looks like this. There are microphones. The sounds you make play back to you in echos!



You usually use LOOP LOVE with Eva or Saoirse! They are our vocal facilitators. But sometimes with Yvon too.





What is Loop Love for? Loop Love echoes your voice so that you can ‘paint sounds’ with it. You can hear yourself alone or in small groups. You make your own kind of voice art with Loop Love!

What happens if you get a ticket? You can get a ticket on the Opera House website.



You come to Cork Opera House at the time it says on your ticket, on Saturday 20 April.



The Opera House looks like this. You go to the brown doors you see here, surrounded by glass.



Friendly people will greet you inside the door, look at your ticket, and will take you upstairs to the Loop Love place, called the Elbow room!
